

1. Department resolution

Botany Department – Resolutions on Educational Tour (September 23–27, 2025)

The Department of Botany resolved to organize an **educational tour** from the **evening of 23rd September to the morning of 27th September 2025** with an objective to enhance experiential learning and field-based understanding of biodiversity, conservation, and applied plant sciences. The following resolutions were made:

1. It was resolved that **50 UG and PG students** would participate in the educational tour along with **four faculty members** of the department.
2. The tour itinerary included visits to **Hogenakkal** to study riverine and hill biodiversity and to **Mettur Dam water reserve** to understand aquatic and riparian ecosystems.
3. It was resolved to study the **floral diversity and ecological adaptations** at **Ooty**, along with visits to the **Tea Factory** and **Government Botanical Garden** to understand industrial and horticultural practices.
4. The team resolved to visit the **Botanical Survey of India (Coimbatore)** and the **Institute of Forest Genomics and Tree Breeding** to gain insights into ongoing research, plant taxonomy, conservation, and genetic improvement of forest species.
5. A visit to the **ISHA Foundation Meditation Centre** was resolved to promote awareness of environmental harmony, sustainable living, and the interrelationship between nature and wellness.
6. It was resolved that all students would maintain **field diaries**, record **observations on biodiversity and ecological conditions**, and submit reports after returning.
7. The faculty members were assigned responsibilities for **supervision, safety, academic guidance, and documentation** of the tour outcomes.

These resolutions were approved in the departmental meeting and forwarded to the Principal for necessary permission and arrangements.







6. *Educational Tour Report*

The Department of Botany organized an **Educational Tour** for both Undergraduate and Postgraduate students from **23rd evening to 27th morning of September 2025**. The main objective of the tour was to provide experiential learning opportunities and practical exposure to biodiversity studies, ecosystem observation, and botanical research institutions. A total of **50 students** along with **four faculty members** participated in this academic tour. The itinerary included visits to **Hogenakkal, Mettur Dam, Ooty, and Coimbatore** covering various aspects of biodiversity, plant taxonomy, ecology, and conservation.

Journey Day – 0: 23.09.2025 (Tuesday)

- The tour commenced at **9.00 PM** from **Government Degree College, Puttur**.
- Students and faculty members boarded the bus with great enthusiasm, marking the beginning of the educational journey to **Hogenakkal**.

Day 1: 24.09.2025 (Wednesday) – Hogenakkal and Mettur Dam

- The team reached **Hogenakkal** at **6.00 AM** and refreshed.
- Fieldwork began with the **collection and identification of hydrophytes** around the **Hogenakkal Waterfalls**, emphasizing aquatic plant diversity and ecological adaptations.
- After breakfast at **10.00 AM**, the group departed for **Mettur Dam** at **11.30 AM**.
- Following lunch at Mettur Dam, students carried out **plant collection and ecological observations near water bodies** until 3.30 PM.
- The journey continued towards **Ooty**, where the group arrived in the evening.
- **Night stay** was arranged at **S.K. Rooms Dormitory, Ooty**.

Day 2: 25.09.2025 (Thursday) – Ooty and Coonoor Biodiversity Study

- From **9.00 AM to 1.00 PM**, students explored and collected various taxa across Ooty's rich biodiversity spots:
 1. **Government Botanical Garden** – observation of exotic and native flora.
 2. **Dodda Betta** – study of montane vegetation.



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- 3. **Ooty Lake** – identification of hydrophytes and ornamental species.
- 4. **Rose Garden** – study of ornamental horticulture and floral diversity.
- Lunch was provided at the Rose Garden.
- In the afternoon (**2.00 PM to 6.00 PM**), the group visited **Coonoor** for herbarium collection and sightseeing:
 1. **Sim's Park** – analysis of introduced and endemic species.
 2. **Dolphin's Nose and Lamb's Rock** – study of landscape ecology and vegetation patterns.
- Dinner was served at **S.K. Rooms Dormitory** followed by a **campfire (9.00–10.00 PM)**, encouraging cultural exchange and student interaction.

Day 3: 26.09.2025 (Friday) – Coimbatore Visits

- The team departed **Ooty at 6.00 AM** and reached **Coimbatore by 9.30 AM**, followed by breakfast.
- Visits to premier scientific institutions were conducted as follows:
 - **10.30–12.00 PM** – Visit to **Botanical Survey of India (BSI), TANU Campus** where students learned about **taxonomic research, herbarium techniques, and floristic documentation**.
 - **12.00–1.30 PM** – Visit to the **Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding (IFGTB)** to understand **forest biodiversity, tree breeding programs, and conservation genetics**.
- Lunch was arranged at **IFGTB** premises.
- Post-lunch, the team visited the **Isha Foundation (2.30–6.00 PM)**, exploring the **Meditation Centre and Cultural Heritage Centre**.
- The visit concluded with a **Laser Show on India's Cultural Heritage (7.00–7.30 PM)** followed by dinner at **8.00 PM**.
- The group began the **return journey to Puttur** that night.

Day 4: 27.09.2025 (Saturday) – Arrival at Puttur

- The team reached **Government Degree College, Puttur** safely in the morning by 8.00am, marking the successful completion of the educational tour.



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Outcomes of the Tour

- Students gained **hands-on** experience in **plant collection, identification, and herbarium preparation**.
- Exposure to **aquatic, terrestrial, and montane ecosystems** deepened their understanding of biodiversity and ecological adaptations.
- Visits to **research institutions (BSI and IFGTB)** enhanced students' awareness of current trends in **taxonomy, forestry, and plant biotechnology**.




