

#### Resolutions for IQAC III Quarter Meeting Held on 04-01-2025

- 1. Review of Action Taken Report (ATR) from the previous IQAC meeting
  - The IQAC reviewed and approved the Action Taken Report (ATR) presented by the Coordinator. The implementation of the decisions from the previous meeting was noted as satisfactory, with a few pending items to be addressed in the upcoming quarter.
- 2. Proposal and discussion on introducing new skill enhancement and multidisciplinary courses for UG II and IV semesters
  - It was resolved to introduce multidisciplinary courses such as "Sustainability
    in Agriculture" and skill enhancement courses like "Data Analytics in
    Biological Sciences" and "Soft Skills for Employability" for UG II and IV

semesters. The curriculum for these courses will be finalized in consultation with the Academic Council.

#### 3. Review and restructuring of timetables for better academic alignment

 The IQAC approved the proposal to restructure the timetables, ensuring a balanced distribution of workload for students and faculty. Special slots for skill development, project work, and extracurricular activities will be incorporated.

#### 4. Discussion on industry internship, partnerships, and evaluation mechanisms

 It was resolved to strengthen partnerships with industries in biotechnology, agriculture, and IT sectors to offer internships and hands-on training to students. A committee will be formed to devise evaluation mechanisms for internships to ensure uniformity and transparency.

# 5. Review of quantitative metrics and DVV benchmarking documentation (2021-22 to 2023-24)

 The IQAC thoroughly reviewed the quantitative metrics and DVV (Data Validation and Verification) documents. Minor corrections were identified and will be addressed before final submission. It was resolved to streamline data collection processes for better accuracy in the future.

#### 6. Presentation and analysis of SWOC report for institutional improvement

o The SWOC (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Challenges) report was presented and analyzed. Key strengths such as experienced faculty and infrastructure were highlighted, while challenges like limited industry partnerships were discussed. Actionable recommendations were noted for addressing weaknesses and leveraging opportunities.

#### 7. Initiatives to enhance student-centric activities and employability skills

 It was resolved to organize more student-centric workshops, career counseling sessions, and training programs in collaboration with industry experts.
 Programs like mock interviews, resume writing, and entrepreneurship development will be conducted regularly.

Learning Enhancement Program," were appreciated. New proposals, including
a "Research and Innovation Hub" for student projects and collaborations, were
approved for implementation.


