Plan of action	Action Taken
To establish additional classrooms for the newly started courses in UG & PG.	3 additional classrooms were constructed in the commerce block under RUSA funds.
To extend ICT facilities to the classrooms wherever it is needed.	ICT facilities were provided for the requirement of faculty.
To extend Wi-Fi facility to the students in the college campus.	It will be provided in due course.
To provide adequate infrastructure net facility to the newly constructed central library.	A new Building was constructed and proposals were submitted to CCE for infrastructural facilities.
