5. Aim & Objectives:

- To familiarize college faculty with the guidelines and framework of NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) for effective documentation and record maintenance.
- To ensure faculty understand the importance of systematic and evidence-based record-keeping to enhance institutional quality and accreditation outcomes.
- To provide training on organizing and presenting data for various NAAC criteria to streamline the accreditation process and achieve better grading.

6. Brief Report

An orientation program on **NAAC Records** was conducted on **30/09/2023** and **05/10/2023**, under the guidance of **Dr. P. Sujana**, IQAC Coordinator. The program aimed to train faculty on maintaining systematic and comprehensive records aligned with NAAC's accreditation criteria.

The sessions were attended by **Principal Dr. G. Srinivasulu Reddy**, **Vice Principal Dr. G. Koteswaraiah** and Academic coordinator **Sri V. Veeraiah**, along with **47 faculty members**. Dr. P. Sujana provided detailed insights on how to prepare detailed and comprehensive documentation for each criterion, including collecting relevant data, providing concrete evidence to support claims of excellence in various areas, and conducting analysis. During the training, there was a strong emphasis on quality benchmarking. College faculty were encouraged to benchmark their programs and practices against NAAC's quality parameters. The program concluded with an interactive discussion, where participants clarified doubts and shared ideas for enhancing the institution's accreditation preparedness.

7. Outcome:

- Faculty gained a clear understanding of NAAC documentation procedures and the significance of maintaining systematic, evidence-based records.

- Mr. Sri Krishna, ASWO(STVD) (Assistant Social Welfare Officer, Special Type and Vigilance Duty), Satyavedu, Social Welfare Department, Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The purpose of their visit was to cross-check the financial evidence in the scholarship portals of the state government from your college. College Principal Dr. G. Sreenivasulu Reddy, IQAC Coordinator Dr. P. Sujana, NIRF & AISHE coordinator Dr. Sankara Rao and Computer Operator Sri. Venkatesh have participated in this audit to provide information from our College login. The team randomly selected four students from each program and verified the sanctioned. scholarship amounts with their data. The findings of this audit will be submitted as a report to the Government of India for review and further action if necessary. This audit is likely being conducted to ensure transparency and accountability in the disbursement of scholarships to SC (Scheduled Caste). This comprehensive audit approach is essential to ensure that the scholarship program effectively serves its purpose, maintains financial integrity, and supports the educational and social inclusion of SC students.
