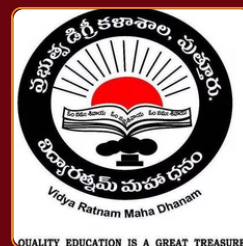

Awareness Programme – “Super GST – Super Saving”

The Department of Commerce organized an Awareness Programme on “Super GST – Super Saving” on 6th October 2025 as part of the Statewide Campaign on GST 2.0, under the guidelines of the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education, Andhra Pradesh.
